The Limerick Hotel is situated on the corner of Park & Clarendon Streets, easily accessible by car, tram or shanks pony.

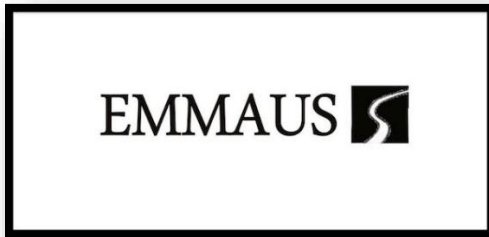
Emerald Hill Seniors
